The National-means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) of Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development was launched in May 2008 with the objective to award scholarship to meritorious students of economically weaker section to arrest their drop out at class VIII and encourage them to continue the study at secondary stage. One lakh fresh scholarships of Rs. 12000/- per annum per student are awarded to selected students of class IX every year and their continuation/renewal in classes X to XII for study in a State Government, Government-aided and Local body schools under the scheme.

2. The scheme is fully boarded on National scholarship Portal (NSP) since 2017-18. Therefore all the applications were invited online. However, due to various technical problems, all the eligible students could not register themselves on NSP. Therefore, all the left-out cases before the project year 2017-18 (Exam year 2016) are being considered in offline mode and no fresh proposal from the project year 2018-19 onwards are being considered in off-line mode. Since the project year 2017-18 is going to be complete in 2020-21, **therefore it has been decided that the left-out cases may be considered and completed in 2020-21 only and no offline case will be consider from the year 2021-22.**

3. In view of above you are requested to kindly furnish all the left out cases in one-go by 30.09.2020 with the certification that no further offline application are left out in your State/UT.


