

NATIONAL APTITUDE TEST IN ARCHITECTURE
(NATA)

What is NATA?

The National Aptitude Test in Architecture is a national level examination for admission to undergraduate courses in Architecture which is conducted by Council of Architecture, New Delhi.

Eligibility for Admission into Architecture Course:

1. Secured at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination.

(OR)

Passed 10+3 diploma examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

2. The candidates who have qualified the aptitude test **i.e.**, NATA or JEE, with pass percentage in 10+2 scheme of examination with PCM or 10+3 Diploma with Mathematics shall be eligible for admission to B.Arch., course for the academic session 2021-2022.

EXAMINATION FEE

Application fee payable by a candidate applying for NATA - 2021, for any one test is INR Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) payable through ONLINE mode. Application fee payable by a Candidate who wishes to apply for both first and second test, is Rs.4000/- (Rupees Four thousand only).

Application Fee payable by candidates belonging to SC/ST and PWD and trans-sexual category for any one test is Rs.1500/- (Rupees One thousand five hundred only) and for both tests is Rs.3000/- (Rupees three thousand only).
